It just hit me; we are worse than the fallen angels (demons) that followed Satan and were cast out of heaven, when we do not recognize Jesus IS our conversation. Sin is denying Jesus as Your EVERYTHING! **Killing cancer sin, not candy sin!**

PASTORS, I'm speaking to you as well. Is Jesus Christ your Lord, Savior, Master, and Friend or is He your calling or your spiritual gift? Is He your-everything or are you worn out talking about Him all week long at your *job* instead of being filled to overflowing by praising Him because He is your-everything? Do you escape life to have some time on your own and not have to talk about Jesus?

Doing your "job" of sharing Jesus is not it. Jesus is not our "job," He is our-everything seen in everything, always! If not, we need to get on our knees and recommit everything, especially the way we *think*, *teach* and *preach* for we will be accountable for it.

When we go backwards to the beginning, everything comes from Jesus. John 1:1-4 says, "In the beginning was the Word (Jesus), and the Word (Jesus) was with God, and the Word (Jesus) was God. He (Jesus) was in the beginning with God. All things came into being by Him (Jesus), and apart from Him (Jesus) nothing came into being. In Him (Jesus) was life and the life was the light of men. So, who IS every conversation? JESUS!

Where did the chicken come from that you are going to eat tonight at dinner? JESUS! He made the first chicken that made an egg and made a chicken that made an egg etc.... You get the idea? Jesus is everything and IS IN every good thing!

If we are so afraid of losing something here on earth, then earth appears to be our final destination. Live in this world, but don't be ruled and controlled by this world; you're not of it!

When we stop believing that Jesus IS everything we will have to fit Him, what truly is everything, into only some-things.

John 3:16-18 says,

"For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son (Jesus), that whoever believes in Him (Jesus) shall not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁷ For God did not send His Son (Jesus) into the world to condemn the world, but to **save** the world **through Him** (Jesus). ¹⁸ Whoever believes in Him (Jesus) is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already **because they have not believed** in the name of God's one and only Son (Jesus)."
