Does it really sink into us that if someone has not said yes to Jesus, they have said no and have earned everything that hell has to offer!

God is great not because of what He has done or is going to do, but because **He Is GOD!**

Which one of these statements is truth to you as exampled by your life?

- 1. Follow your heart.... or, "Follow Me (Jesus)"
- 2. Be true to yourself... or, "Whoever wants to be My disciple, must deny himself"
- 3. Believe in yourself, or, "Believe in Me (Jesus)"
- 4. Live your truth, or, "I am the truth (Jesus)"
- 5. As long as you are happy, or, "What will it profit a man if he gains the world and looses his soul?"

Jeremiah 17:9-10 says, "The heart is more deceitful than all else, and is desperately sick; who can understand it? I, the Lord, **search the heart**, I **test the mind**, even to give to each man **according to his ways**, according to results of his deeds."

Remember John 3:18? Whoever believes in Him (Jesus) is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son (Jesus)."

If you have never given your life <u>completely and fully to Jesus Christ</u>, this is the time to do it. Don't let Satan's fear, guilt and shame hold you any longer! From the depths of your heart, which God searches, confess to Jesus that you are a sinner and need saving. Believe that He is the one and only Son of God.
